



What is ALS?

The Australian Linguistic Society is the national organization for linguists and linguistics in Australia. Its primary goal is to further interest in and support for linguistics research and teaching in Australia.

The Society, established in 1967, publishes the *Australian Journal of Linguistics*, a journal of international standing, which includes articles from all areas of linguistics, although having a particular focus on linguistics carried out by Australian linguists or about Australian indigenous languages or Australian English.

ALS also holds an Annual Conference, and every few years runs the Australian Linguistics Institute.

Why should you join?

There are various benefits of joining the Australian Linguistic Society. Besides the intangible benefits of belonging to a network of Australian linguists, supporting linguistic research and teaching in Australia, and having a say in the future of linguistics in Australia, there are other more tangible benefits.

- Members receive a free subscription to the *Australian Journal of Linguistics*, with three issues per year.
- Members receive the quarterly Newsletter (plus occasional additional correspondence about more urgent matters), with details about conferences, job opportunities, grants, new books, and other information relevant to linguists in Australia.
- Members are entitled to present papers at the ALS Annual Conference, and receive discounted registration rates for these conferences and the Australian Linguistics Institute.
